#### **Training under Integrated Scheme for School Education**

**District- Junagadh**

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## **Introduction:**

District Institute of Education and Training – Junagadh is a nodal agency of the district Junagadh working under Gujarat Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT-Gujarat) which works with the aim of Quality enhancement in School education through various In-service and Pre service programmes for teacher education. Therefore, the programs and activities proposed for the year 2021-22 are based on the need of the district for improving overall quality of education.

In the present context, the role of DIETs is providing pre-service and in-service teacher training to student trainees and in-service teachers. It is time that DIETs rise up to the challenge and emerge as a robust unit for professional development of teachers.

To fulfil the aim The DIET will work in the area of developing instructional material, imparting training, promotion of innovative practices and researches and so on. The DIET also undertakes various types of researches under the guidance of Gujarat Council of Educational Research and Training (SCERT-Gujarat).

## **Integrated Scheme for School Education:**

Under the Integrated Scheme for School Education, the proposal of AWP 2020-21. The total budget proposed for AWP&B for the year 2020-21 is 347.80 lakh. This total budget covers different components for DIET - Junagadh.

1. Civil Works for existing DIETs– 0.00 lakh
2. Equipment in TEIs – 0.30 lakh
3. Technology Support to DIET (Non recurring)– 2.40 lakh
4. Salary of faculty and staff sanctioned and filled up - 188 lakh
5. Programme and Activities of DIET – 30.00 lakh
6. Faculty Development of Teacher Educators –2.00 lakh
7. Specific projects for Research activities - 5.00 lakh
8. Recurring Support on Technology in Teacher Education – 2.40 lakh
9. Annual Grant for TEIs – 20.00 lakh

**The brief note on above components is stated as under.**

### **1. Equipment in Teacher Education Institutions:**

Equipment's in DIET Junagadh are Sound system for Training hall for the year 2021-22 and for these expense 0.30 lakh is calculated.

### **2. Technology Support to DIET:**

Information and communication Technology (ICT) has become one of the basic building blocks of modern society. The Government of India seeks to strengthen the use of ICT in almost every sphere.

To promote the use of ICT in school education (2004) and The Digital India Campaign (2015) strives transform India into a digitally empowered society by focusing following three areas.

1. Digital infrastructure
2. E-Governance and services on demand
3. Digital Literacy and empowerment of citizen.

Under Non-recurring Grant, DIET Junagadh propose financial budget of Rs.2.40 lakh which covers mainly three parts such as (A) Hardware and software, (B) Connectivity and Power supply (C) Furniture.

The DIET proposed 6.00 lakh budget for Interactive boards, Scanner with printer, Internet connectivity with lane, softwares related research and education, Tablets, Laptop, etc.. DIET Junagadh proposed 0.20 lakh for Operating System and Application software and 0.20 lakh for furniture.

### **3. Salary of faculty and staff sanctioned and filled up**

The yearly salary is counted and proposed for Academic and Non academic faculty and staffs is 188 lakh from which salary for the Principal, Senior Lecturer Junior lecturer and para academic staff will be paid.

### **4. Programme and Activities of DIET**

Programme and Activities are the core elements so far as Quality improvement of education and teacher education is concerned. The programmes and activities are planned round the year at state and district level looking to the need, area and research basis for education. The total amount proposed for Programme and Activities is 30.00lakh.

## **5. Faculty Development for Teacher Educators of DIET**

Developing and implementing rigorous, need based programs for academic & vocational capacity for teacher educators supporting pre-primary, elementary, secondary and senior secondary levels with the support of SCERT, DIETs and other Allied Institutions is a major task under this component. Faculty development programmes are designed by DIETs under the guidance of SCERT.

As per the guidelines laid down, initially budget plan of 2.00 lakh for Faculty Development Programmes was prepared by each DIET. The proposed programmes under this component are representing the following subject areas. :

Exposure visit of various DIETs, Schools, BRCs, CRCs etc.

Visit of best Educational Institutes of Gujarat State.

Visit of best Educational Institutes of India.

Visit of SCERTs of Rajasthan, Maharashtra and Kerala

Branch wise Faculty Development Programmes by SCERT.

DIET specific need based Faculty Development Programmes in Subject areas like Research, ICT, SPSS etc.

## **6. Research Activities by DIET**

DIET Junagadh has planned the research activities for developing effective evaluation processes to empower the state education department to assess educational outcomes in various forms, including. The same is not limited to student achievement, teacher performance and teacher educator performance. DIET Junagadh will undertake contextual and academically rigorous research projects which will improve the policy making process of the state education department.

As per the guidelines laid down in draft document of SMSA, initially budget plan of 5.00 lakh for Research activities.

The proposed research and research related activities under this component are representing the following subject areas. :

Educational difficulties of disabled students Eco club activities

Effectiveness of ICT training programme

Seminars for research related presentations

Abstracting of researches at district and state level

## **7. Recurring Support on Technology:**

There are four main components such as

1. E Content and Digital Resources -0.24 lakh
2. Charges for Electricity/Diesel/Kerosene/Solar Power-Hybrid solar - 0.24 lakh
3. Internet connectivity 0.12 lakh and
4. Financial Assistance for ICT Instructor @Rs. 15000/- per month

In this way total proposed amount for DIET Junagadh is 2.40 lakh per institute is recommended as per guideline for teacher education institutes.

## **8. Annual Grant for DIET**

Annual grant for DIET Junagadh is to be used for day to day expense, Electricity expenses, Telephone expenses, Vehicle allowance, purchase of library books, Computer repairing and maintenance, Office equipment - Table, rack, podium, Photocopy, Office Stationery, Anti-virus for computer, TA/DA for onsite support and other training programs, Out source wages, Day to day office expenses and meeting expenses, Mobile and internet bill, Experts honorarium for training  
As per guideline, the financial norm for DIET is Up to 20.00 lakh. per annum.
